Chapter 11

ADMISSIONS STATISTICS

This is probably the core data which you will want to review in depth to determine your chances of admission to medical school after your GPA and MCAT have been considered.

I include whether a medical school is public or private for a simple reason. Your best chance of admission to medical school is the public institution of your home state.

Although I tell you the fee to complete a secondary application, the goal was not to show how expensive applying to medical school can be. Rather, your likelihood of moving forward in the application process.

If I were you I would get excited if I received a secondary application from a school which screens their applicants. This means you passed the first test, because not everyone does, and now the medical school wants to know more about you.

Remember, this is not the last hurdle you still need to be invited to an interview.

When it comes to interviewing the consensus for most schools is that you are good enough on paper to be admitted, but now we need to see if you are who you say you are and whether you have normal social/communication abilities.

Lastly, not everyone who gets invited to an interview will matriculate (attend/enroll) and I provide this value as a point of reference.

I can only say reference because it is not possible to determine if an applicant who interviewed declined their offer of admission or was denied admission by the medical school.

You will find I broke down the admission values by residency status because this can make a huge difference in how you are viewed by the admissions committee. For instance, an out of state resident will have a harder time getting interviewed at a public medical school as opposed to an in state applicant.

Finally, the medical schools that interview the lowest percentage of applicants are more competitive, therefore you will need a higher GPA, MCAT score, strong letters of recommendation, and compelling personal statement to move forward in the admissions process.
